### Three Part Invention

This patterned cowl includes a slip stitch pattern, a traveling-twisted-stitch pattern, and a knit-and-purl pattern, and is an excellent way to learn all three. The patterns stand out well enough to be used with a solid, semi solid, or wild multi-colored yarn.

#### Materials:

- 2 skeins of "Kirby Woolpaca" from Osborn Fiber Studio (109 yards, worsted weight, shown in colorway "Crazy Crayons").
- 16" US 8/5mm circular needles
- 1 stitch marker

#### Abbreviations & Techniques:

- K: Knit.
- P: Purl.
- CO: Cast on.
- BO: Bind off.
- CN: Cable Needle.
- Tbl: Through back loop – Insert the needle into the back leg of the stitch before knitting or purling.
- K2tog: Knit two together.
- KFB: Knit Front Back – Knit in the front and back of the same stitch.
- S11: Slip 1 purlwise with yarn in back.
- LT: Left Twist – S11 to CN and hold in front. P1; K1tbl from CN.
- RT: Right Twist – S11 to CN and hold in back. K1tbl; P1 from CN.



**Gauge:** 5 st/in in stockinette in the round.

**Size:** Finished measurements are about 22" around, after blocking.

#### Garner Stitch (in the Round):

Round 1: K.

Round 2: P.

## **Directions**

### **Section 1: Slip Stitch Columns (20 rounds)**

CO 88. Join in the round, being careful not to twist. Place a stitch marker to mark the beginning of the round.

Rounds 1-7: Work 7 Rounds of Garter Stitch, ending after a K Round.

Rounds 8,10, and 12: \*Sl1 wyib, P3\* to end.

Rounds 9,11, and 13: \*K1, P3\* to end.

Round 14: K.

Rounds 15,17, and 19: P2, \*Sl1, P3\* until 2 stitches remain; Sl1; P1.

Rounds 16,18, and 20: P2, \*K1, P3\* until 2 stitches remain; K1; P1.

### **Section 2: Slip Stitch Lattice (20 rounds)**

Rounds 1-7: Work 7 Rounds of Garter Stitch, ending after a K Round.

Round 8: \*LT, P4, RT\* to end.

Round 9 and all remaining odd rounds in this section: Ktbl all knits and P all purls.

Round 10: P1; \*LT, P2, RT P2\* until 7 stitches remain; LT; P2; RT; P1.

Round 12: P2; \*LT, RT, P4\* until 4 stitches remain; LT; RT; P2.

Round 14: P3; \*RT, P6\* until 5 stitches remain; RT; P3.

Round 16: P2; \*RT, LT, P4\* until 6 stitches remain; RT; LT; P2.

Round 18: P1; \*RT, P2, LT, P2\* until 7 stitches remain; RT; P2; LT; P1.

Round 20: \*RT, P4, LT\* to end.

### **Section 3: Basketweave (21 rounds)**

Rounds 1-2: Work 2 Rounds of Garter Stitch.

Rounds 3 and 5: KFB; K to end.

Rounds 4 and 6: P. (90 stitches)

Rounds 7, 8 and 9: \*K3, P3\* to end.

Rounds 10, 11, and 12: \*P3, K3\* to end.

Rounds 13, 14, and 15; \*K3, P3\* to end.

Rounds 16-17: Work 2 Rounds of Garter Stitch.

Rounds 18 and 20: K2tog; K to end.

Round 19 and 21: P. (88 stitches)

### **Finishing**

Bind off all stitches and weave in ends.  
Block.
